"**Pink eye**" is a term that may sound scary, but this common eye problem typically is easily treated and, with a few simple precautions, can often be avoided. The primary types of conjunctivitis, based on cause, are:

Viral conjunctivitis. Caused by a virus, like the common cold. This type of pink eye is very contagious, but usually will clear up on its own within several days without medical treatment. (child must stay home)

Bacterial conjunctivitis. Caused by bacteria, this type of conjunctivitis can cause serious damage to the eye if left untreated.(very dangerous –child must stay home.



Snacks:

As a 'Healthy School' we promote that the children only bring healthy snacks for their morning recess such as: fresh fruit and vegetables, yogurt and cheese. Please avoid sending **Fruit Roll-ups, Soda, Candy, Chocolate and Chips** at all times.

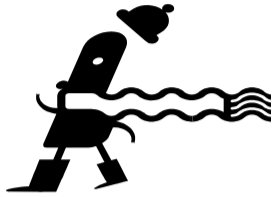
(Practicing healthy eating habits with our children produces healthy adults!)
